ICC also strengthens communities through advocacy, neighborhood organizing, and community development initiatives.

## ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Order and maintain pantry inventory for distributions
- Receives food deliveries at respective sites and does direct activities at each site
- Register new clients and maintain existing clients in the digital system
- Coordinates food delivery drivers
- Coordinates the mapping of food delivery for various programs
- Serves as the point person for out Table to Table distributions every Thursday
- Ensure all food safety procedures are followed
- Ensure clean-ups take place after each distribution
- Recruits and coordinates all volunteers
- Tracks volunteer on site clearances and stipend
- Tracks and maintains food distribution meal count database
- Establish and maintain relationships with food donors
- Coordinates across all programs to ensure we are providing food resources across all ICC programs
- Collaborates with ICC Farm Crew around distribution of produce grown at Down Bottom Farms
- Assess neighborhoods in Ironbound not being reached and plan for mobile food distribution days
- Identifying locations for winter distribution site
- Ensures to promote all other ICC programs and work through our COVID-19 relief and response efforts
- Conduct additional duties as assigned
